



Virginia Technical Institute uses the curriculum from the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER), which is a standardized training process affiliated with the University of Florida. Each trade takes approximately 2 years to complete. You may research your trade choice on our website. Use link <http://www.govti.org/courses> . Just click on your trade choice and you can download and print the competencies & objectives.

The first classes you would take are CORE & your Level 1 trade. CORE is a class that covers the basics of safety, construction math, hand tools, power tools, blue prints, communication skills, employability skills and materials handling.

If you are interested please let us know and we can set up an appointment for you to come in, complete registration and tour the facility.

Cost of the CORE & Level 1 trade class is approximately \$1768 or \$1868 for Welding.

Cost of PLC and Levels 2-4 classes is approximately \$1719 or \$1819 for Welding each semester.

Cost of Marine trades program is approximately \$2000 each semester.

Costs per class per semester:

CORE & Level 1 Tuition - \$700 each

Levels 2-4 Tuition - \$1400 each

PLC tuition - \$1400

Marine Trades tuition - \$1650

CORE & Level 1 Lab fees - \$99 each

Welding Level 1 Lab fees - \$199

Welding Levels 2-4 Lab fees - \$299 each

PLC & Levels 2-4 Trade Lab fees - \$199 each

Marine Trades Lab fees - \$199

CORE book - \$80

Level 1 books - \$90 each

PLC & Levels 2-4 books - \$120 each

Marine Trades book - \$151

Currently, we do not have tuition assistance. We do offer a payment plan. We ask that you pay for your lab fees and book fees at the time of registration. After a \$25 service charge, tuition is divided into 4 equal payments of \$356.25 or \$418.75 for Marine trades, payable the 1st of the month for the next 4 months.
